Admiralty Tide Tables - General.

In the British Isles, Chart Datum is approximately the level of Lowest Astronomical Tide (LAT) and all metric charts are referred to this level. For the few remaining fathoms charts, a correction to the predictions from Admiralty Tide Tables (ATT) may be required. A comparison between the tidal heights given in the tidal information panel on the chart and those given in Part II of ATT will show the amount involved; when such a correction is necessary the amount should be subtracted from the height predicted in ATT.

Elsewhere, the level of Chart Datum is determined by the country having primary charting responsibility for the area.

Corrections to Vol. 2

The tidal predictions supplied by the German Hydrographic Office for publication in the 2005 Edition of Admiralty Tide Tables, Volume 2 (NP202-05) have been computed to LAT, whereas Admiralty Charts refer all depths in German Waters to MLWS.

Therefore, 0.5m must be *deducted* from the heights of all tidal predictions for Helgoland, Cuxhaven and Wilhelmshaven published on pages 27-37 before applying them to the depths on Admiralty Charts covering German Waters in order to determine the correct water depth.

Mariners using German Tide Tables in conjunction with Admiralty Charts should refer to Weekly Edition No 36/2004 of the German Notices to Mariners.

Mariners are advised that the tidal predictions derived using the current and pending 2005 editions of TotalTide (DP550) are *not* similarly affected. TotalTide computes the predictions for each German port to MLWS and will continue to do so until the datum of the relevant Admiralty Chart is changed to LAT.
